

TARA MOBILE CRECHES

Workers on construction sites normally move around from one place to another in search of a livelihood. Families living on the construction sites often live in unhygienic conditions, without electricity and clean drinking water. While the parents are at work, their children live in an unsafe environment. The children do not have access to their basic rights of safety, health care, nutrition and education. Who will provide these to them?

Tara Mobile Creches, Pune (TMCP) is a non-profit organization, set up in 2007, to ensure that the construction worker's children enjoy the right to safety, healthcare, education, recreation and participation. We operate centers, or creches, on construction sites in and around Pune. At these centers, we provide a stimulating environment that fosters the importance of good childcare and contributes to the safety and all-round development of the children on the site. A qualified, experienced, and well-trained team of staff-members and 'karyakartas'(workers), trained in childcare by TMCP, manage the creches.

TMCP supports the rights of the child:

Tara Mobile Creches Pune's objectives revolve around ensuring that every child enjoys his or her basic rights. These rights have been embraced and adopted by the Convention on the Rights of the Child. The rights are as given below:

- 1.The right to grow up and to develop physically and spiritually in a healthy and normal way, which is free and with dignity.
- 2.The right to a name and nationality.
- 3.The right to special care and protection, to good food, housing and medical services.
- 4.The right to special care if handicapped in any way.
- 5.The right to love and understanding, preferably from parents and family, but from the government where these cannot help.
- 6.The right to go to school for free, to play, and to have an equal chance to develop to be responsible and useful.
- 7.The right to be always amongst the first to get help.
- 8.The right to be protected against cruel acts or exploitation.
- 9.The right to be taught peace, understanding, tolerance and friendship among all people.
